The Incoming Exchange Student Allowance Scheme (IESAS)	
Introduction	With the establishment of the academic agreements of the two institutions to pursue collaboration on academic activities for promoting the advancement of international understanding, academic excellence, dissemination of learning and strengthening cultural ties, Hong Kong Design Institute (HKDI) invites students from partner institutions to come and study at HKDI for a period of up to five months (one semester). The exchange programme aims to foster the exchange of creative ideas and cultural understanding through first-hand interaction amongst students.
Requirements	The incoming exchange students who apply for IESAS are nominated by their home institutions in their third or final years of undergraduate studies or currently studying for a postgraduate degree.

	<p>Non-credit bearing students are expected to interact with HKDI students and actively participate in design-related events during their stay in Hong Kong:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Share knowledge and expertise with HKDI's higher diploma students to enhance their international exposure, cultural experience and research potential; 2. Provide academic coaching, guidance and advice to HKDI's higher diploma students on specific areas of design studies; 3. Conduct research studies of their own choice advised by senior academic staff of various departments at HKDI, namely: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Department of Architecture, Interior & Product Design; - Department of Communication Design and Digital Media; - Department of Design Foundation Studies; - Department of Fashion and Image Design; and 4. Participate in HKDI students' learning activities, such as project works and field studies. 	
Contact Hours	The incoming exchange students under IESAS are usually required to commit no less than 110 contact hours (approximately 6-6.5 hours per week) throughout the scheme to meet and interact with HKDI's higher diploma students.	
Tuition Fee	The registered students of the partner institutions who join the IESAS will be exempted from the tuition fee of HKDI, in accordance with the memorandum of understanding.	
Allowance	A monthly allowance of HKD9,750 ^{#1} will be provided to support the stay of the incoming exchange students under IESAS covering accommodation, meals, transportation and miscellaneous expenses.

<p>^{#1} The allowance is eligible only for the incoming exchange students under IESAS who received valid study visa issued by the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) and completed the student registration process at HKDI. The amount of allowance is subject to annual review.</p> <p>^{#2} VTC Halls of Residence (Pokfulam and Tsing Yi) would be an option and if they choose to stay in the dormitory, a monthly allowance for meals, transportation and miscellaneous fees at HK\$7,000 will be provided. The accommodation fee of VTC Halls of Residence is subject to annual review.</p>
